First Racing of the Season

Race #1 of the Mike Walden Michigan Points Series kicked off Sunday afternoon, May 18th, with unseasonably cool and windy conditions. With the temp struggling to top 50°F, winds gusting to over 30 mph and the well used legs of the racers who had the day before competed in the Kensington Road Race, the riders unanimously voted to make the day a training race.
