Team Red and Team Neon again matched each other for points in the Miss & Out with 15 pts. Team Pink was still in the game by adding 10pts. So going into the final 10 Mile Madison Team Red and Team Neon were tied with 44pts each.

In the first sprint of the final Madison Team Neon took the first place pts. Team Red got caught in traffic and finished 4th. Team Pink won second place pts and was closing in on Team Red. In the second sprint Team Red finish first followed by Team Neon and Team Pink.

In the third sprint Team Pink won followed by Team Neon and Team Red. So going into the final

double pts sprint of the Madison Team Neon was ahead with 68pt, Team Red with 62pts, Team Pink with 50pts, Team Blue with 34pts and Team White with 30pts.

The final sprint showed the strength and speed of Team Red as the dominated the final sprint and won the 20pts. Team Neon and Team Pink finished second and third. But the Officials announced that Team Red and Team Neon were tied in points for the overall win.
